



**Did you think I was joking about the parking inspector, then think again!** The School Council has requested some new parking restrictions to be put in place by our trusty Shire.

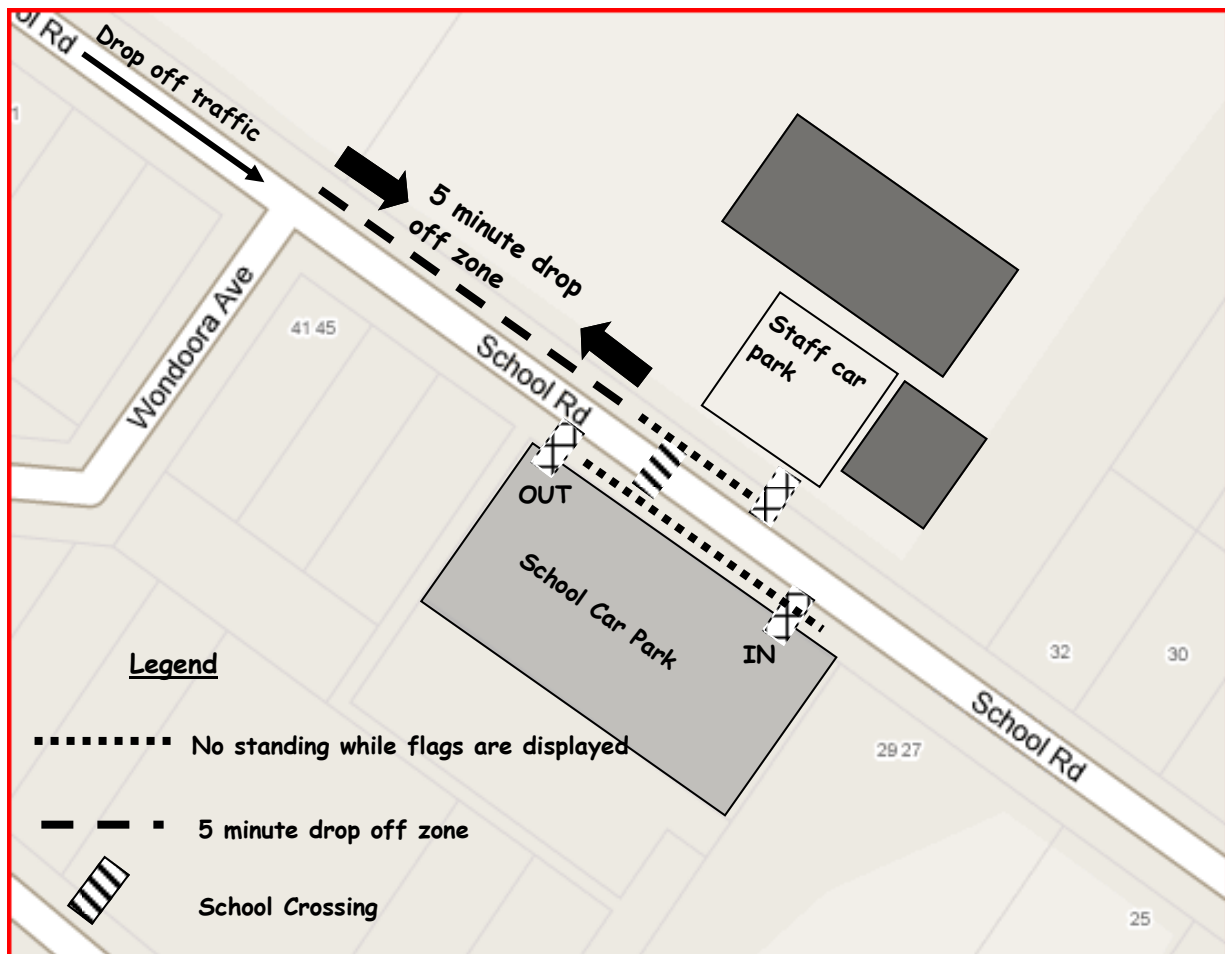
We have asked the Shire to erect signs designating a Drop Off & Pick Up zone on the school side of School Rd as shown on the diagram below. The Drop Off zone will be best used by coming down School Rd from the One Tree Hill Rd direction to avoid doing U turns in School Rd. Leave the car park for those who need to park for longer than 5 minutes.

Read the parking signs because they are about to change, by the way don't mistake the Mobile Library parking signs for the extent of the no parking area opposite the staff car park entrance, the no parking area extends to the other side of the "In" entrance to the school car park. If you park there I'm sure the Shire would love to take your money.

Just a reminder of the protocol for using the school car park, please reverse in to your parking spot as it is far easier to see if it is free of children and safe to park and when leaving be able to clearly see forward, the alternative, to drive in and then reverse out into the car park traffic is far more hazardous to small pedestrians. Also please don't stop in the middle of the car park to let the kiddies out, take the extra 30 seconds to reverse in to a car park and let the traffic keep flowing, other people's time may be just as valuable as yours (hard to believe isn't it)

#### Things to consider:

1. Use alternative Drop Off and Pick up areas at the Bus Stop or Pine trees
2. Use the new 5 minute drop off & pick up zone but approach from One Tree Hill Rd
3. Use the School Car Park if you need to stay but observe a few easy guidelines
